

**All the rules for visiting Wetherspoon when pubs reopen on April 12**

Pub chain Wetherspoon will reopen almost 400 of its pubs on Monday as England's lockdown restrictions continue to ease.

Among those reopening are 13 Merseyside pubs, which will offer a slightly reduced menu, with food available from 9am to 8pm seven days a week.

Wetherspoon is opening many of its beer gardens, rooftop gardens and patios as pubs and restaurants will only be allowed to open for outdoor services from April 12.

Beer gardens across Wiltshire can reopen on April 12 – but will your local Wetherspoon be among those reopening?

Selected pubs will open from 9am to 9pm from Sunday to Thursday and 9am to 10pm on Fridays and Saturdays, although some will have restrictions on closing times.

They will offer a slightly reduced menu, with food available from 9am to 8pm seven days a week.

Customers can order and pay through the Wetherspoon app and staff will be able to take orders and payment at the table.
